

Pershing's Track Team Qualifies 19

Pershing High lived up to its role of favorite in the Metropolitan League's East Side track meet yesterday, qualifying 19 contestants in preliminaries in nine events.

Denby, the defending champion, was second with 11. Northern had eight; Cass Tech and Miller each seven; Northeastern four; Southeastern and Eastern three each and U. of D. two. The finals will be held tomorrow on the Denby track.

Pershing placed in every event, with three boys in the 220, 440 and half mile; two in the 100-yard dash, shot put, broad jump and mile run; and one each in the high and low hurdles.
