Cody Speedsters Keep Track Title

Led by a slender senior and two converted baseball players, Cody High School captured its second consecutive City League and broke an 880-yard relay record to boot.

Jim Ruddy, a tall, frail-looking letterman, pulled up 28 1/2 of the Comets' 77 26/35 total points.

He took firsts in the 120-yard low hurdles and the 100-yard dash, a third in the broad jump and led the 880-yard relay team to a record time of 1:30.2.

CODY'S RELAY squad of Ruddy, John Anderson, Hugh Grunfeldt and Chuck Novotny sped around the quarter-mile distance (increasing of a second faster than a 1955 Miller High School squad that held the previous time of 1:30.5).

Carl Genalak and Novotny, two seniors who traded baseball bats for sweat suits this spring, also had a big share in Cody's winning point total.

Genalak collected 19 12 1/2 points on a tie for first in the broad jumps, a tie for fifth in the pole vault and a tie for sixth in the high jump.

Novotny earned 16 1/2 by defeating City dash champion Bob Manning, of Western, in the 220-yard dash, taking fourth in the 100-yard dash and anchoring the 880-relay.

Mackenzie beat off a last-minute challenge from Redford for second place with 44 points in the pole vault. Mackenzie maintained 118 lead with second and third places by Jim Oliphant and Ron Jenkins to finish second with 66 points.

REDFORD WAS third with 60 3/5, followed by Mumford 45 29/25, Central 13 1/2, and Western 42 28/35.

Northwestern picked up seventh place with 29 2/7, points trailed by Chapey 17, Colley 19 and Southwestern 8.
