

Doughboys Lead Track Qualifiers

Pershing High, its eye on the City League track title, strengthened its bid Tuesday by dominating the qualifying chase.

The Doughboys became firmer favorites for Thursday's crowning as result of the action at Denby which drew all point winners from last week's East and West Side championships.

Pershing led the qualifiers by placing 11, three in the half mile.

The East Side champions added medley and 880-yard relay teams but missed out in the high and low hurdles and the pole vault.

CODY, WHILE shut out in the shot put and the half mile, had nine qualifiers.

Carl Genslack is figured as a sure point getter for the West Side champions in the pole vault, the high jump and the broad jump with Chuck Navotny and Jim Ruddy favorites in the sprints and the low hurdles.

The Comets' record breaking 880-yard relay team was altered when John Grech replaced quarter-mile Hugh Grandfeldt but managed to qualify with a time of 1:31.1.

Grandfeldt, ailing with a pulled muscle, was the number one three man on the Cody team that established a record of 1:30.2 at the West Side meet. Grandfeldt won a place in the

440-yard run with a third in his heat.

MACKENZIE, Redford and Northern each qualified eight performers.

Mackenzie and Northern are also entered in the 880-yard relay along with Western, which placed four other boys.

Mumford is in both relays in addition to qualifying five performers.

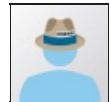
