

# Redford, Denby Win Track Bow

## Falcons' Dinkins Takes 4 Events

Neither wind nor cold could keep 12 City League track teams from their appointed rounds Thursday.

The snappish winds and chilly temperatures forced cancellation of only the Pershing-Mackenzie nonleague meet on the opening day of the league's outdoor season.

Redford, a strong favorite for the West Side crown, overpowered Cass Tech, 81 to 28, and Denby slipped by Northeastern, 60½ to 48½.

**THE HUSKIES** showed surprising strength in the hurdles as Charlie Mattson took the 120-yard lows in :13.5 and the 180-yard highs in :16.1. They also got a 4:40.9 mile from Louis Molnar.

Mike Dinkins picked up four of Northeastern's first places in its loss to Denby with victories in the low and high hurdles, the high jump and the broad jump.

Western eased by Southwestern, 61 to 30, winning eight of the 11 events in a shortened meet and Northern defeated Southeastern as Edgar Clark collected 15 points in a 65-43 victory.

**LEAGUE** champion Edsel Reid tossed the shot 51 feet, 8¼ inches in leading Chadsey to a 55½-50½ victory over Cooley. Bob Small collected two of Central's first places with triumphs in the dashes in a 59-23 victory over U. of D. High.
