## Bearcat Trackmen Lose Night Meet

JACKSON—The night was frigid and the results bone-chilling for Battle Creek Central High School's undermanned track team here last night as Jackson scored a 60½ to 48½ Six-A Conference dual meet victory over the Bearcats.

Coach Chuck Cacek's Bearcats scored the majority of first places, seven to six, but Jackson won both relay events to account for 10 points against 0 in those races.

## Bruin Net Golf Squads Gain Split

Battle Creek Community College tennis and golf squads split in matches with Benton Harbor Junior College at the Lake Michigan coast city yesterday.

The netters scored a 5-2 victory over the Harborites while the golfers lost an 8½-6½ decision.

The Bruin racquet-swingers won four of the five singles matches and then captured the second doubles. Hank Rolfe had a tough time in the No. 1 singles where he had to go three sets before beating Don Engler. Art Richardson lost a 3-setter in the No. 3 singles.

The golfers played some of the best golf of the season at Berrien Country Club but still lost. Don Davis led the linksmen with a 39-38-77 for medalist honors while Benton Harbor's Don Parks and Dick Bicknell had 78s.

Leroy Brown gave the Bearcats a pair of firsts by taking both sprints, the 100 in 10.5 seconds and the 220 in :24.2.

Sophomore Jim Cope zipped around the quarter-mile in :53.0 for another Central first and teammate John Love leaped 20 feet, 2 inches to win the broad jump.

Bearcat Charles Marshall came home first in the half-mile run in 2:11.0 and teammate Jim Longsdon wrapped up the shot put first spot on a heave over 42 feet. Charles Moles won the pole vault for Central at 10 feet, 2 inches.

Jackson picked up vital points by sweeping the mile, headed by Joe Modena who clicked off the distance in the brilliant time of 4:37.4.
