MONROE—Warren Cawley, of Farmington, and Rem Purdy, of Grosse Pointe, were among the early winners Saturday night in the second annual Monroe Relays.

Cawley, who earlier in the day had won both the high and low hurdles at the Albion Invitational, captured the high hurdles here in the record time of :14.6.

Purdy established himself as Michigan's foremost schoolboy miler when he turned in a sensational 4:27 effort, nearly two full seconds under the present state Class A mark. Both Cawley and Purdy are juniors.

Pontiac High, the team favorite, got away to a fast start setting meet records in both the shuttle hurdle and 880-yard relays.

Redford Union's Russ Lechel won the broad jump with a leap of 21 feet 11½ inches. Chuck Gibson, of Birmingham, took the shotput when he tossed the 12-pound ball 50 feet 6½ inches.
