

Hurdler Equals State Mark

There was a festive air at the Inter-Lakes League track championships yesterday, it being Bermuda Shorts Day at host Farmington High, and Warren Cawley did his best to preserve the holiday atmosphere.

The Farmington junior enhanced his reputation as perhaps the top high school hurdler in the state by winning the high and low hurdles in record time. Cawley also set a high

jump mark and ran on the record-setting 880-yard relay team.

Cawley gave his performance before an estimated crowd of 600 people, most of them clad in Bermuda shorts. Even members of the Farmington coaching staff had their knees showing.

"You can blame me for that," reported Jack Cotton, Farmington's athletic director. "I made a bet with the student council that they couldn't sell

over 200 tickets to the meet. They sold over 300 so the members of the coaching staff had to wear Bermudas, too."

One who didn't go through with Cotton's bargain was Track Coach Gene Freed.

"He chickened out at the last minute," laughed Cotton.

In winning the low hurdles in :14.4, Cawley equaled the Class A state record set by Hayes Jones, now of Eastern Michigan

College, in 1956. Cawley's time in the highs was :19.5 while he hit 5-11 $\frac{3}{8}$ in the high jump.

Led by Cawley, Farmington was able to outscore defending champion Waterford, 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 50 $\frac{5}{6}$. Walled Lake took third with 45 points, followed by Southfield (14), Berkley 11 $\frac{1}{3}$) and Van Dyke (10 $\frac{1}{3}$).

Meet records were quick to

fall as Dearborn rolled up 63 points to defeat Edsel Ford (54) and Fordson (20) in a triangular meet. Dearborn's Al Bates lowered the 880 mark to 2:04.5 while teammate John Harley tied the 220 record with

Edsel Ford's Don Taylor lowered the mile record to 4:36.8 while Dearborn's sprint relay team turned in a record 1:34.6 clocking. Russ Spearman, of Dearborn, picked up a double in the hurdles.
