

Farmington Wins First Track Title

Farmington High won its first Inter-Lakes conference track and field championships in 11 years Wednesday.

The Falcons captured six firsts and accounted for four of nine records set in rolling up 63½ points. Waterford, the dethroned champion, finished second with 50 5/6 points followed by Walled Lake 45, Southfield 14, Berkley 11½ and Van Dyke 10½.

WARREN CAWLEY, of Farmington, and **Frank Fink**, of Walled Lake, were the top individual performers. Cawley set records in winning the high and low hurdles and the high jump and then came back to anchor his winning 880-yard relay team.

Fink, competing with a stitched hand, set records in the 100 and 220 and also won the pole vault.
