JUNIOR SCORES 26 POINTS IN TRACK

Sanders Paces Pershing

"He's the best all-around athlete in Detroit," remarked Mike Haddad as he pointed toward a tall, lithe youngster relaxing between events in the Metropolitan League East Side track meet at Pershing yesterday.

The Pershing football coach was referring to Lonnie Sanders, who shared individual scoring honors with 26 points while leading Pershing to the sectional team title.

Sanders, a 17-year-old, 6-foot-2 junior, won the high and low hurdles, was fourth in the broad jump and ran the first

leg on the Pershing sprint relay which placed second to Mumford.

Felton Rogers, of Eastern,

also had 26 points on first in the high jump plus seconds in both hurdle races.

"Last year Lonnie was the league half mile champion but Carl Holmes put him in the hurdles this year and you saw what he did," Haddad continued. "He was a great end for me last fall and was just as good in basketball."

The firsts Sanders took in the hurdles were all that Pershing had but the defending champions showed team balance by placing in every event as they piled up 833 1/2 points Denby, with four individual

winner, failed to place in four events and was second with 69 points.
