

# 7 Records Set in Meet at Thurston

Seven records were broken and another tied as Thurston High won its fourth annual invitational track meet yesterday. Thurston took five firsts and scored 91 points. Taylor Center had 64½; Northville 51; West Bloomfield 41½; Troy 35½; and West Bloomfield 22½.

Three marks were set by Thurston runners. The medley relay was lowered to 2:40.8; Dick Jaros ran the 440 in :51.6; and Tom Evanoff took the 180-yard low hurdles in :20.1.

Gary Burgess, of Taylor Center, was clocked in 4:59.7 for the mile and Wayne Woodford, of the same school, won the half mile run in 2:09.9. Northville took the half-mile relay in 1:38.5 and Bill Johnson, of Troy, hit 11 feet 2 in the pole vault. Wayne Thweat, of Taylor Center, equaled the high jump record of 5 feet 6.

Tom Newton, of West Bloomfield, was the only double winner, taking the 100 and 220-yard dashes.
