

# Redford Class A Winner in Relays

Despite the disqualification of its half-mile relay team in the last event, Redford High won the Class A division of the second annual University of Detroit relays Saturday, edging Pontiac's state champions by half a point.

Redford, favored to take the Metropolitan League team honors also this week, finished with 27½ points. Pontiac had 27 and Birmingham 23.

River Rouge won the Class B division for the second straight year, rolling up 44 points to 26 for runnerup Ecorse.

Competing in every event except the broad jump, Redford won three of the 11 events, the shot put, two-mile and four-mile relays, setting a meet record of 8:25.4 in the two-mile. Central ran it in 8.34 last year.

Making up Redford's two-mile team were Lionel Hurd, Terry Moore, Howard Weliver and Jack Roberts.

Art and Len Cranston and Chuck Elmquist put the shot for a combined total of 140 feet 7¾ inches, while Henry Lennox, Dick Rix, Cameron Howie and Louis Molner took the four-mile in 19:22.1.

Bob Manning, the state 100 and 220-yard champion, Jim

Hawkins and Jim Keller ran Pontiac's three relays, while Jim Keller was on the 440 and Charles Borge in the hurdle race.

Pontiac led in four events, the 440, half-mile and shuttle hurdle relays and the high jump, setting records in all.

The meet's biggest upset came in the pole vault in which Bill Alcorn, of Birmingham, who set a state scholastic record of 12 feet 11¾ inches at Ann Arbor, was beaten by Jerry DeHenau, of Denby. DeHenau never before had gone higher than 11 feet 8, but Saturday he went over the bar at 12 feet 5½. Alcorn's best was 12 feet 3.

Birmingham, however, has the best team total of 33 feet 11 inches, Denby placing third.

River Rouge won five Class B tests, leading in the shuttle hurdle, quarter-mile, half-mile, four-mile and medley. The defending champions bettered meet records in the hurdle, four-mile and medley.
