

IN LEAGUE track meets. Mumford trounced the University of Detroit High, 93 1/6 to 15 5/6, with Fred Prime collecting almost enough points himself to top the Cubs.

Prime picked up 15 1/2 points on firsts in the high hurdles, pole vault and high jump and a tie for third in the low hurdles.

Felton Rogers won the high and low hurdles and tied for first in high jump in leading Eastern to a 77 1/2-37 1/2 decision over Southeastern.

Northwestern trimmed Southwestern, 62 to 38, with Colt John Robinson running a leg of the 880-yard relay and winning the high and low hurdles.

Redford blasted Cooley, 82 to 27, and Denby defeated Cody, 63 3/4 to 45 1/4, in other meets.
