

Redford, Pershing Pace Metro League Track Trials

Cooley High, once a power in track, will be only an also ran in the Metropolitan League championships on Mackenzie's track tomorrow. But the day will not be a total loss for Cooley Coach Claude Snarey. He'll be pulling for one of his former boys to win the team honors.

Bruce Waha, who put the shot for Snarey on Cooley's championship of 1944, is coaching Redford which became the favorite to take the meet by placing nine individuals and two relays in the trials yesterday. Defending champion Pershing placed two relays and eight individuals.

Heats were not held in the mile run in which two leading

contenders have two entries apiece. The Redford contestants are Louis Molnar and Lionel Hurd, first and fourth in the West Side meet last week, while Pershing's Steve Jarmon and Paul Kaczmar were third and sixth on the East Side.

Redford's best event was the half mile with Martin Chapin, Jack Roberts and Jack Moore taking three of the six qualifying places. Redford also has two boys in the shot put and the pole vault.

In the shot put, Len Cranston, of Redford, tossed the 12-pound ball 51 feet 7 3/4 inches for a 10-inch advantage over Edsel Reid, of Chadsey.

Mackenzie's hopes were weakened when Jim Oliphant injured his back while pole vaulting Monday. He still managed to qualify in that event as well as the high jump and high hurdles, but failed in low hurdles.

Finals in the field events begin at 2 p.m. tomorrow, the races starting at 3.
