

County Runners Second in Meet

Kalamazoo — Three Genesee County League runners finished high in races here Saturday night in the annual Champion of Champions prep track meet.

Miler Jerry Bashaw of Lincoln Park nipped Bendle's Jim Farnett at the wire in an eyelash finish of a 4:36.2-minute mile. Fenton's Bob Taylor was second in a :51.9 440-yard dash race. Kearsley's Bill Baldwin lost his first 880 race of the year, finishing third behind Paul Underhill of South Lyons and Robert Weyland of Howell. The winning time was 1:59.

Pontiac's Bob Manning won the 100 in 10.1 seconds and the 220 dash in :22.4. Dave Voorheis of Frankenmuth was fourth in each race. The Pontiac medley team won in 2:27 minutes and the 880 relay in 1:30.9.
