

WSU's Telford Flashes Past 'Recordholder'

CHICAGO — John Telford, former Wayne State quarter miler, won the 600-yard run Saturday at the National Junior AAU track and field championships.

Telford, representing the Detroit Track Club, was timed in 1:14.4.

Jimmy Bibbs, also of DTC, set a meet record of 0:06.3 in the semifinals of the 60-yard dash but finished third in the finals behind Al Jacobs. Jacobs, of the Chicago Track Club, lowered Bibbs' record to 0:06.2.

Farmington High senior Warren Cawley, State high and low hurdles champion, ran unattached and set a meet record of 0:07.5 winning the 60-yard highs.
