Flint Central won its first Huron Relays title as six records were smashed and two others tied in the 13-event program which attracted 700 athletes from 37 Class B schools.

A BREEZE AT BOWIE

Vertex Wins 2nd '100-Grander'

BOWIE, Md.—B—Vertex, a fragile legged horse, turned into a well-beeled one Saturday by easily winning the John B. Campbell Handicap for his second \$100,000 victory in a week.

AS A RESULT, Vertex rewarded them at only \$3.80, \$3.20 and \$2.30. Bonocrat Farm's Backbone returned \$6.60 and \$4.20 while third place Talent Show, owned by Mrs. Ada L. Rice, paid \$5.60.

Vertex, who has had frequent leg trouble including loss of part of a hoof, ran as sound as an old dollar in covering the mile and a sixteenth in 1:43 1-5.

He was carrying 124 pounds, ranging from seven to 14 more than any of his nine rivals. A week ago he won at Gulfstream carrying 129 pounds for a mile and a quarter.

It was the third victory in four races for Vertex this year. He wound up his 1958 campaign with a triumph in the Pimlico Special the day before his sire, the Rhymer, was burned to death.
