

# Huron Relay Popularity May Force Entry Limits

YPSILANTI — Huron Relays have proved so successful, Meet Director George Marshall says next year's running may have to be limited to the 40 high schools presently participating.

"We just can't handle any more entries," explained Marshall who has had to convert Bowen Fieldhouse offices, classrooms and refreshment stands into dressing rooms.

In the two-day affair, more than 1000 prep thinclads participated. In Saturday's Class A preliminaries and finals there were more than 700 entries.

On Saturday night a near-capacity crowd of 1,500 fans saw two Flint squads, Central and Northern, sweep past the other 30 high schools. While both placed in seven events, Central won 515 6-43, carrying off four firsts while Northern captured two.

New Relays records were established in six of 13 events and two records were tied. Two marks established in the first running of the Relays in 1956 by world-record-holding Huron hurdler Hayes Jones, when Jones was a senior at Pontiac Northern, were improved by Farmington's Warren Cawley.

The only double-event winner, Cawley bettered the 65-yard high hurdles mark by two-tenths of a second and improved the old record of :07.5 in the 65-yard low hurdles by one-tenth.

Ann Arbor's 19 Pioneer en-

tries did not succeed in placing in any event. However, Willie Haywood ranked sixth in the shot put, one place short for earning team points.

Ypsilanti High's participants also failed to gain any points.

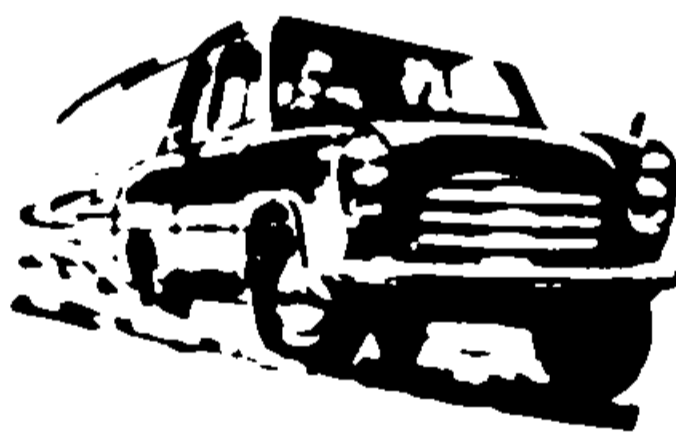
