N'western Is Edged in Track

Art Norman struck a hurdle yesterday and Northwestern High's hopes of victory went down with him.

Art was leading in the 180-yard low hurdles when he sprawled but managed to get up and salvage third place. The first two places went to Norm Dozier and Jim Lucas and that was enough to give Southwestern the dual meet, 56-52.

Dozier also led in the 120-yard high hurdles. Henry Carr gave Southwestern firsts in the 100, 220 and broad jump. Talt Malone scored 10 1/4 points for Northwestern. He was first in the high jump, second in the 100, third in the broad jump and ran on the sprint relay.

EASTERN ROLLS

Eastern smothered Southeastern, 86-22, as Felton Rogers made 16 1/4 points and Irv Green 11 1/4. Felton led in the high jump and both hurdles, Irv taking the 100-yard and broad jump. Both ran relay legs.

Dave Shevitz won the 100-yard dash and low hurdles as Mumford crushed Cass, 91 1/6 to 18 5/6. Mumford athletes took 11 firsts. Denby whipped Osborn, 78 1/2 to 30 1/2. Denny Eichinger had 12 1/4 points on firsts in the high hurdles and broad jump and a four-way tie in the high jump. Russ Stabile took the 100 and 220 besides running on Denby's winning sprint relay.

Jim Boggs swept the dashes and Gordon Kumoner took the hurdles as Mackenzie beat Cody, 62 1/2 to 46 1/2.

FINAL RACE DECISIVE

Northern captured the sprint relay to defeat Northeastern, 48-43. The meet was tied going into the final race.

Rex Cawley starred with 14 1/4 points as Farmington downed Southfield, 61 1/3 to 40 2/3. Rex ran off with both hurdle races, was second in the high jump and anchored the sprint relay.

Clair Carney's firsts in the broad jump, 100 and 220 sparked U. of D. High's 79-20 triumph over Salesian.

Mumford defeated U. of D., 4 to 2 1/2, in tennis although Matt Murphy, of U. of D., surprised Paul Silva, 4-6, 6-4, 6-4, in the No. 1 singles.
