Prep Hurdles Sets 2 Records

MANSFIELD, O. April 18 — Warren Cawley, of Farmington, Michigan's finest schoolboy hurdler, established two records in the qualifying heats of the 28th annual Mansfield Relays here today.

The slim speedster skimmed over the 120-yard high hurdle course in 14.3 seconds, then came back with a 19.0 clocking in the 180-yard lows.

Cawley clipped a tenth of a second off the high hurdle mark set last year by Dan Lee, of Mt. Lebanon. Pa. His time for the lows was five-tenths of a second off the national scholasic record.

Two Flint Central athletes did well in qualifying heats, too, Bill Morrison placing in the low hurdles and Ron Watkins in both the 100 and 220-yard dash events.
