

## Mumford Rolling in City Track

Weightlifting is paying off for the Mumford High track team.

After a winter of exercising with bar bells and the foot weights, the Mustangs are burning up City League tracks.

Thursday they defeated Pershing, 62-47, missing two league records by less than a second.

**KEN BURNLEY** was 1/10 second off the record of 0:21.7 with a 0:21.8 time in the 220. He also won the 100-yard dash which was run over a 120-yard course through a starter's error.

The Mustang's 880-yard relay unit won in 1:30.7, 6/10-second off the record.

In other action, defending champion Redford won every event except the 220 and the low hurdles in a 74-35 victory over Mackenzie, sophomore Henry Carr won the 100 in 10 seconds flat for one of his three firsts in Southwestern's 72½-32½ victory over Western, and Denby took 10 firsts in a 69½-39½ triumph over Cass Tech.

Dennis Holland won the dashes and the broad jump to lead Cody to a 71½-37½ victory over Cooley and Northeastern won an indoor meet from Central, 53½-32½, with Tom Kemp earning 11½ points for the winners.
