

Cawley to Run For Spartans

East Lansing — Warren Cawley, modest Farmington High school track star and class A state hurdles champ, is keeping his fingers crossed these days and waiting official confirmation from the National High School Athletic federation for a possible share of the national high-hurdles record in the prep division.

Cawley, a fierce competitor, was by far the top athlete in the state class A finals Saturday at Michigan State's track. The youngster, determined not to finish behind in any event, captured both hurdle events with stellar performances along with the broad jump when it appeared he was doomed for second.

In taking the 120-yard high hurdles, the Farmington senior tied the state record of 14.4 twice, once in the morning preliminaries and in the afternoon finals.

While he walked off with the honors, Cawley was the first to admit he had his eye focused on the national mark of :13.9 set by George Hoogerhdye of Ardmore, Pa., in 1957.

In the class A regionals at Detroit last week Cawley traveled the high timbers in :13.9, his second best performance of the season. Charles Forsythe, Michigan State High School Athletic director, submitted Cawley's :13.9 for official record consideration.

Earlier in the year, and with the aid of the wind, he was clocked in :13.4.

Work, determination and standout coaching by Head Coach Gene Freed, University of Michigan graduate, are the factors leading to Cawley's success. The 18-year-old youngster, standing 6 feet and weighing 155 pounds, gave his coach all the credit in his sensational showing at the state finals.

Cawley will be performing for Michigan State as the Farmington senior plans to enroll at the East Lansing institution next fall. Cawley admitted he had many attractive offers from midwest colleges, but plans on majoring in radio and television and picked the Spartans.
