

# Mumford, Eastern, Pershing Rule East Side Track Trials

Three schools — Mumford, Eastern and Pershing—monopolized the Public School League's East Side track trials on Pershing's track yesterday, leaving all others far behind. They should finish in that order in the finals tomorrow.

Placing in all events except the shot put, Mumford qualified 22 boys to 18 for Eastern and 16 for Pershing. No eliminations were held in the sprint and medley relays.

Mumford's strength was in the running events with 15 qualifiers — three each in the 100, 220, 440, half and mile. Eastern had four in the shot put, three each in the broad jump and high hurdles. It failed in the 100, 220 and mile. Pershing placed three in the half and mile runs, missing out in the 100 and 220.

## BIG TURNOUT HELPS

"The only way I can explain our performances in the running events is that we had a big turnout for them," said Mumford Coach Stan Mullin.

"We had nine boys out for the shot this season and probably would have had another

qualifier if Tom Flower hadn't dropped out to take a job after school," said Lorenzo Wright, coach at Eastern. "He was our third best boy."

The best competition came in the broad jump where three boys bettered 22 feet. Melvin Jenkins, of Central, cleared 22 feet 4½ inches on his last jump to go ahead of Homer Heard, of Mumford, who leaped 22 feet ¾. Lonnie Sanders, of Pershing, did 22 feet 1 and Jerry Burrell, of Northern, was a quarter of an inch under 22 feet.

West Side schools held their trials today at Mackenzie and decide their team and individual championships Thursday.

Each section qualifies six in all events for the semifinals at Pershing June 2. The finals are at the same track two days later.
