

# Krause County Champion

Champion of Champions was an appropriate name for Saturday afternoon's track meet at Viking Field as far as Bendle High's Paul Krause was concerned.

The meet, sponsored by the Flint Olympian Games track committee, was labeled in such a way because the leaders of both Genesee County Leagues, Classes B and C, were invited to compete.

With all the potential of a fine decathlon prospect, Krause was the meet's champion — winning four first places in impressive style.

He first proves his ability to run (and hurdle) with a 15.4 seconds 120-yard high sticks victory. Then he demonstrated his ability to jump—copping the high jump with a fine six-foot effort and the broad jump with a 21-foot-3 leap.

He saved the best for last, clearing 12 feet in the pole vault. It was a Viking Field record, bettering 11-7½ by Northern High's Jim Collins in 1956.

It was a fine over-all effort for Krause and was in keeping with the caliber of performances in all events. Linden

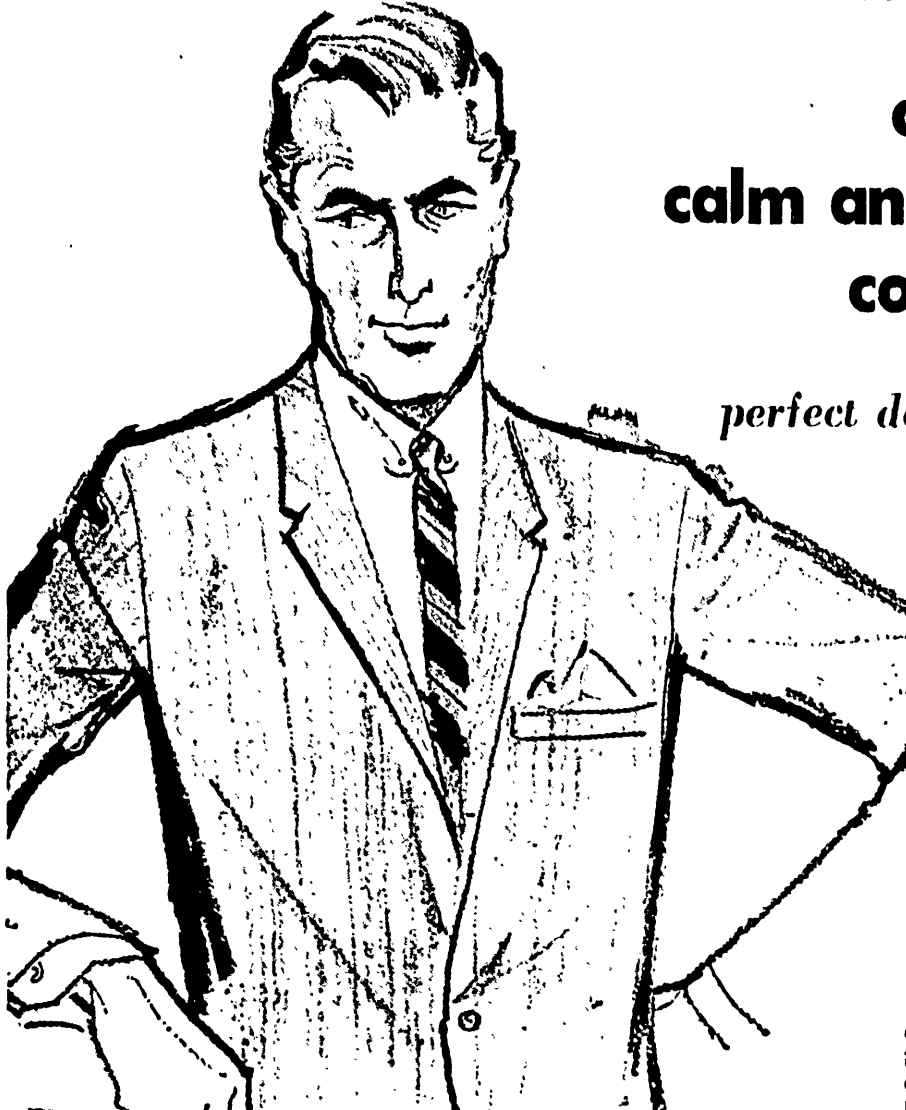
High's Frank Skolowski won his 880 race by 80 yards and even though he wasn't pushed was clocked in a field record 2:00.9 minutes. It bettered 2.021 by Central High's George Friedrictsen earlier this Spring.

Class C Dye proved its re-

lay-team caliber against Class B rivals, taking both the medley in a fine 2:31.6 time and the 880 with the unit of Barry Mishall, Dick Odykirk, Marv Anderson and Buck Miley.

The rest of the firsts went to Class B boys, Grand Blanc's Carl Bekofske being the only

other double winner in the 100 dashes. Harold Barden of Fenton won the low hurdles (20.4), Jim Barnett of Bendle the mile (4:36.6), Dave Hildebilde of Mandeville the 400 (51.6) and Jack Patton of Fenton the shot put (51 feet).
