won the 440 and teamed with Carr, Jeffrey Martin and Eddie King for fourth in the 880-yard relay to give the Prospectors 40 points good for fifth place.

JERRY BURRELL broke his own record in the broad jump with a leap of 23 feet, $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch. He set the record on Tuesday.

Top event of the day was the mile when Terry Moore of Redford set a record with a time of 4:23.6. Defending champion Frank Carissimi of Denby set the early pace with Moore a yard behind. Moore made his move on the back turn and went on to win by 10 yards.

The 16-year-old sophomore started running the mile this Spring and broke the league's oldest record. The previous record was set in 1950.

Another record of sorts was set in the meet when George Gvozdoch of Redford called disqualifications in two events, the first time in memory an inspector had gone to that trouble. He knocked Gary Chapin of

Redford out of first place in the 880-yard run and the Pershing medley relay team out of sixth place, both for fouling.
