Marathon Timing Perfect

Hamilton Laments First Rain in Weeks

Hamilton, Ont. — "What a time to get our first rain in six weeks."

Many a Hamilton person had that remark Saturday when a drizzling rain dampened the CANUSA Games. Hamilton, which annually gets less rain than other cities in Ontario because of its location in a valley, has had no appreciable rain since mid-July.

But rain couldn't dampen the enthusiasm. The weatherman was nice enough to stop the rain during the official ceremony. The highlight of the torch-lighting ceremony was the appearance of Dale Fyfe, 16, with the torch carried 225 miles from Flint to Hamilton by a team of 22 runners.

Timing was fabulous. In fact, if the official ceremony had started at 1:05 as scheduled the torch would have been perfect. As it was, the runners were slowed a bit during the last lap.

Fyfe saw bad luck turn into good luck. He placed in the hop, skip and jump in the Flint Olympic Games but that event was not contested in his age group in the CANUSA games. So, Fyfe asked about joining the marathon crew. He pulled the lucky number to carry the torch the final three miles into Hamilton's huge Civic Stadium.

Len Pickett, who won the 880-yard run in the 13-14 age group, volunteered to run in that event. "He's a shot putter," said Bruce Jacobs, one of Flint's track supervisors, "but he made up his mind to win that 880. That's the way we like our boys to perform."

Jacobs and Norbert Bader, Northern high track coach, were enthusiastic over Flint's track performance.

"Give our Genesee County League schools plenty on credit," Jacobs said. "We would be short in a lot of events if those boys and girls didn't compete."

AC Spark Plug Division, donor of the Friendship Trophy which is property of the host team for a year, was represented by Hugh Curtis, works manager and Willis J. (Speed) Oldfield, director of advertising and sales promotion.

The caravan carrying Flint's athletes home will depart at 8 A. M. (Flint time) and is expected to arrive at Ballenger Field House about 4 P. M.
