

PREP STAR GOES TO SOUTHERN CAL

MSU Loses Hurdler Cawley

EAST LANSING, Sept. 23. — When Michigan State started classes this week, it learned it has lost Rex Cawley, the Farmington schoolboy who startled track fans this year.

Cawley was considered on his way to Michigan State until a week ago. A sudden change of mind took him to Southern California.

"He didn't make up his mind until just before he left for the coast," said his mother, Mrs. Harry Cawley. "It had nothing to do with track at either school. He just thought he would be further ahead by going to Southern California."

Cawley, who set a national schoolboy record in the high hurdles last spring and won three events in the Class A high school meet, had been sought by a number of schools.

Under the Big Ten financial aid plan for athletes, Cawley was not eligible for financial assistance from Michigan State. Southern California isn't bound by the same code.

Also, Cawley intends to major in radio and television. By

migrating to Los Angeles he has positioned himself in the center of the industry.

Among those taken by surprise by Cawley's move was Spartan Track Coach Fran Dittrich.

"He didn't take Cawley's loss as hard as might be expected," said a University official. "It probably means, however, that our teams here for the next few years will be only average instead of good."
