

Denby Miler Tops Record In First Try

Frank Carissimi had his first "official" crack at the State high school mile record this season and it was all he needed. The 135-pound Denby senior ran the mile in 4:28 flat Thursday to become the fastest indoor miler in Michigan school-boy history.

Carissimi easily shattered the mark of 4:31.1 held by Jan Bowen of Alma.

But Carissimi's record run couldn't help his Denby mates as they bowed, 57-43, in a City League dual-meet opener against Pershing.

In other meets Northwestern's powerhouse buried Cody, 63-28; Cass Tech slammed the 440 and 880 as it downed Southeastern, 57¼-33¾, and Cooley routed Mackenzie, 62-29.
