

MSD Is Fourth

Area Athletes Win Five Tests

Mt. Pleasant Five sparkling performances by Flint-area athletes produced individual crowns in the State Class C and D track meets here Saturday.

The champs were:

- Dick Schlegelmilch, Bentley, who won the Class C pole vault at 12-1.

- Russ Husted, Atherton, who exhibited near-perfect form in 120-yard high hurdles (15-1 seconds) in Class C.

- Dick Warren, Morrice, who took the Class D 220 in 2:2.

- Brown Jordan, Michigan School for the Deaf, 180 low hurdles king in Class D in 20.1.

- Bob Scripser, Jordan's teammate, who had a 2:07.9 clocking in the 880, best of two heats.

Schlegelmilch, seeking a State record (he's cleared 13-4 for this year); was forced indoors by rain. He went outside for a crack at Dean Look's four-year-old mark of 12-6 but missed three times at 12-7.

Jordan was a big reason MSD got 21 points, behind winning Covert's 34½, Schoolcraft's 24 and Spring Arbor's 23. Haslett, which won the Flint Class C regional, had 19 to take the State title. East Jackson had 17.

Jordan in the high hurdle qualifying Saturday banged a timber halfway down the track, lost his balance and failed to reach the finals. In the low final he beat Wes Butcher, Spring Arbor, and Norm Kohns, Newaygo, in a thrilling race. Butcher was timed in 20.2, Kohns in 20.3.

Scripser grabbed the 880 lead midway in the far straightaway of the first lap and kept it to the end. Teammate Gerald Blakely was third in his heat.

Wilburt Reed's second in his 440 heat and MSD's medley relay club, which finished second as Caswell Hassell ran a fine closing 440, helped give the Tartars their best finish since

they were second in 1950.

Walt Reinhold, Frankenthum, was fifth in the Class C 220 with North Branch's Ron Ward fourth in the C mile, won by Haslett star Dick Pickering in record 4:33.4 clocking.

Montrose's Mike Coke had a good but second-place effort his 880 heat while Bentley's Bill Voce got boxed in early and failed to place.
