Denby Star Runs Mile In 4:22.4!

Frank Carissimi, Michigan's fastest schoolboy miler, did it again.

Carissimi bettered the mile marks Thursday for the third time this season. The 135-pound Denby flash ran the mile in 4:22.4 to top Terry Moore's record of 4:23.6 on an outdoor track.

Carissimi had bettered the indoor mark twice this year with his best time at 4:27.7. The slight senior also holds the City League's cross-country record.

Denby won 12 events and tied for first in the other as it smashed Southeastern, 87-21.

CHARLES HINES won the high and low hurdles and the pole vault to pace Southwestern's 68½-40½ victory over Cooley. But Charles Louis bettered Hines' feat as he won the same three events and the broad jump in Eastern's 65-44 victory over Cass Tech.

Northwestern slammed Mackenzie, 85½-23½, as it swept the 440-yard, 880-yard and broad jump events.

Mumford, defending City League champion, routed Northern, 70-39, and Redford bumped Ford, 66½-42½.

In suburban meets, Ecorse, the state's Class B power, ripped Cranbrook, 66½-42½, and Fordson outran Wyandotte, 77 1/6-31 5/6.

DeLaSalle, the Catholic League champion, defeated U-D High, 77½-31½, as Jerry Deska won the high jump, and high and low hurdles.
