

Cawley Back, Sets The Pace

Warren Cawley, a freshman at Southern California who starred at Farmington High two years ago, led the way in the AAU's first of eight summer track meets at Thurston yesterday.

Cawley was the only cinderman to win two events, taking the 440-yard run and 120-yard high hurdles. He was clocked in a fast 46.7 seconds in the 440.

Dave Shevitz, former Mumford ace, won the 100-yard dash in 9.6 seconds, and Denby's Frank Carissimi, who set a new city prep record in the mile with a 4:17.7 timing, grabbed the half-mile event in 1:58.

Michigan State sophomore Jerry Young was first in the three-mile cross-country run in 15:34, and Bill Pritchett, state shot-put champion from Pontiac Central, won the 16-pound event with a toss of 47 feet 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches.
