9.3-Mile
Race at DRC

Al Confalone, 28-year-old draftsman from Salem, Mass., won the 15-kilometer (9.3 miles) national AAU run Sunday at Livonia.

Confalone led his Boston Athletic Club team to an easy victory over a Livonia course which started and ended at the Detroit Race Course.

A fourth-place finisher earlier this year in the 26-mile Boston Marathon, Confalone's time of 51 minutes and 37 seconds was considered excellent on a hot and humid afternoon.

WHILE VETERANS Hal Higdon of Chicago and Ed Duncan of Boston chased Confalone home the real surprise of the day was 19-year-old Frank Carissimi, the Denby High miler, who finished fourth.

Carissimi was clocked in 54 minutes and 33 seconds, only three minutes behind the winner.
