## What New Records For Carr to Better?

What's next for Henry Carr?

The fleet Northwestern High star is obviously too good for the Metropolitan League, and for that matter most any prep loop in the country.

HE COULD very well be Detroit's first Olympic Games representative since Lorenzo Wright who competed in the 1948 games. Wright is now track coach at Eastern High.

Yesterday in the league's west side track preliminaries, Carr broke both his 100 and 200-yard dash records and did it in such convincing fashion as to make the other speedsters look poor by comparison.

Carr sprinted the 100 in a 9.6 second clocking and returned later to run the 220 in 20.8 seconds. These times beat the Metro records he set last year in the city meet

when he was running for Southwestern High.

His 100-yard mark nipped his old standard by one-tenth second and the 220 jog eclipsed his old record of 21 seconds flat.

He also broke the state record in both events, but neither will go into the record books as Metropolitan marks are not recognized by the state body.

About the only things left for Carr to break now are the national high school marks. The American prep standard in the 100-yard dash is 9.4 seconds, held by the fabulous Jesse Owens. He also can gun for the 220 national mark of 20.6.

THEN, TOO, it's conceivable he could tackle the world marks in both events when he gains the necessary experience.

Carr's biggest booster is his track coach, Tom Hendricks.

"Henry is the greatest runner ever to hit this town," he said. "He's a great runner with an even greater temperament."

Hendricks used Carr in the 440 four times this season in duel meets and in one outing he skirled along at a 47.6 pace. The coach indicated at the time he might send Carr to the Olympic preliminary.
