

It's Pontiac All the Way In Track

Chalking up five first places and tying for two others Pontiac Central High won the Oakland County track and field title Sunday, closing out one of its most successful seasons.

Coach Dean Wilson and his state champions piled up 101-3/7 points to 51 29/84 for runnerup Birmingham. Ferndale placed third with 36 1/2, followed by Waterford 30 3/7, Bloomfield Hills 19 and Hazel Park 13 13/14.
