Bellevue Trackmen Lose in Charlotte

CHARLOTTE — Charlotte High outpointed Bellevue in the opening track meet of the season for both schools here yesterday, 66-43. The Broncos of coach Wayne Shaffer made it close despite the fact Steve Cole, star quarter-miler, was out because of illness.

Gary Kokx paced Bellevue on first place finishes in the 440 yard dash, high jump and pole vault to emerge the only triple winner of the meet. Rocky Smith took both dashes for Charlotte. The event winners:

- Mile relay—Won by Bellevue (Shier, Standley, Hargas and Bennett). 4:01.6.
- 100-yd dash—Won by Smith (C). :11.0.

- 220-yd dash—Won by Smith (C). :25.0.
- 880-yd run—Won by Beebe (B). 2:20.0.
- Mile—Won by Martens (C). 5:00.0.
- 180-yd low hurdles—Won by Briggs (C). :22.9.
- 880-yd relay — Won by Charlotte (Rochester, Love, Briggs and Smith).
- Shot put—Won by Carr (C). 35 ft., 7 ins.
- High jump—Won by Kokx (B). 5 ft., 4 ins.
- Broad jump—Won by Rochester (C). 18 ft., 5 ins.
- Pole vault — Won by Kokx (B). 8 ft., 10 ins.
