

# Another Record for Carassimi

Frank Carassimi of Denby High has set another record in the mile.

Yesterday he ran the distance in 4:27.7 clipping three tenths of a second off the record he set last week.

IN SPITE of his efforts Denby dropped a 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ -17 $\frac{3}{8}$  decision to Mumford in a Metro League indoor dual track meet. Ken Burnley led the winners with victories in the 25 and 220-yard dashes and a leg in the winning 880-yard relay.

Cooley swept the mile, pole vault and low hurdles in dumping Chadsey 75-16. The Cardinals won 9 of the 11 events . . . Charles Hines won both hurdles, pole vault and ran a leg on the winning relay as Southwestern stunned Redford 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ -30 $\frac{3}{8}$ . Aaron Clark won the 25 and 220-yard dashes and ran on the relay for Southwestern.

Benedictine defeated Our Lady of Sorrows, 75 $\frac{1}{2}$ -33 $\frac{3}{8}$  in the Catholic League with Dennis Dopke leading the winners with victories in the 100 and 220-yard dashes . . . Tom Pink won both dashes as Dearborn downed Wayne 68 $\frac{1}{2}$ -40 $\frac{3}{8}$ . Frank Worden won both hurdles for Wayne.

HIGHLAND PARK took 11 firsts in defeating Hamtramck 80-25. Dwight Downes led Highland Park with firsts in both hurdles and a tie for first in the high jump.

Henry Carr won the 30-yard dash and 440-yard run as Northwestern defeated Western 71 $\frac{2}{8}$ -19 $\frac{1}{8}$ .
