

**PREP TIMED IN 51.5**

## Henry Carr Runs A Record Quarter

Northwestern High's Henry Carr cracked the 25-year-old City League indoor record for the 440-yard run Thursday as the Colts trimmed Mackenzie, 53-34, in a duel track meet at Mackenzie.

Carr covered the quarter-mile in 51.5 seconds to erase the old mark of 53.4 set by Ulysses Amos of Northwestern in 1936. The meet was run indoors since the outdoor track wasn't in condition.

In other City League action, Stanley Hill grabbed three firsts to pace Western to a Carr 58-33 victory over Cody; John Titcomb won the high and low hurdles in Redford's 77-32 triumph over Henry Ford, and Eastern defeated Cass 50½-41½.

**A THREE-WAY** meet at Thurston High saw the host team finish first with 61 5/8 points to U-D High's 45 and Utica's 28 1/8.

Gary McCabe led the winners with a first place in the 100-yard dash, seconds in broad jump and 220, and a leg on the winning 880-yard relay.

Dearborn won 10 events in whipping Wayne 62-48. Dearborn's Dick Oliver won both dashes.

Gary Schick was the stand-out in Grosse Pointe St. Paul's 61½-47½ triumph over Grosse Pointe University School. Schick took firsts in the high jump and broad jump and seconds in the high and low hurdles.

There were no double winners as St. Joseph edged Hamtramck, 37-36, at Keyworth Stadium.
