DETROIT —(P)— Detroit public schools are a trifle closer to for a two-year trial period. returning to state athletic tournament competition after a for a two-year trial period in lapse of 30 years.

The Detroit board of educail tion yesterday turned down su- tition for the present because of perintendent Samuel Brownell's recommendation that Detroit it public schools should not return to state tournament competition at this time.

Three Alternatives

Instead the seven-member board drafted its own proposal of three alternatives.

1. Return to state competition

2. Return to state competition certain sports.

3. Not return to state compea possible over-emphasis of competitive sports.

A hearing will be held at the board of education offices next Tuesday.

Detroit public schools have been the only ones in Michigan barred from tournament play in basketball, swimming, tennis, crosscountry, golf and track for 30 years.
