

Viking Runners Win 2nd Meet

SAGINAW — Hue Edwards and Dennis McGee paced Flint Northern High to its second straight dual track victory Tuesday. The Vikings trounced host Saginaw Arthur Hill High, 74½-25½.

Edwards picked up 10½ individual points with victories in the 440 run and the broad jump and a third-place tie in the high jump. McGee won the 60-yard dash and the 65-yard low hurdles. Both ran on the winning 880 relay team.

In preparation for Friday's indoor meet at Central Michigan University, both teams agreed to run the indoor distances. The decision cut the 120-yard high hurdles and the 180-yard lows to 65 yards and the 100-yard dash to 60 yards. They did not run the 220 dash.

Northern Coach Norb Badar was pleased with Edwards' 440 clocking of :51.5, considering it outstanding time at this stage of the season.

Northern's Earl Sawyer showed improvement in the pole vault. Sawyer won the event with a vault of 10-6 compared to his 9-6 showing against Flint Central last week.

Northern won 10 of the 12 events and swept the 440 and the pole vault.
