

Northwestern's Henry Carr, hopeful of equaling or surpassing the national high school 100-yard dash record of :09.4 before he graduates next month, turned in a terrific :09.5 effort, Thursday. The Colts defeated Southwestern, 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ - 43 $\frac{1}{2}$. There are rumors that Carr will break the 25-foot barrier in the broad jump this spring. Tom Hendricks, his coach, won't comment on this possibility.

George Harris turned in a fine 1:58.6 half mile in leading Eastern to a 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ - 46 $\frac{2}{3}$ victory over Denby. Henry Williams scored 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ points, including victories in both the 100 and 220, in leading Northeastern past Southeastern, 71-38.
