

Traverse, Leel Pickford Win

Traverse City successfully defended its Petoskey Relays title for the sixth year out of 10 here last night, easily winning the class A-B division with a 317 point total in a field of six schools. In addition they set a new record in the 1/2 mile relay at 2:28.6, shaving off 1.59 of a second off the old time of 2:30.2 set by the Trojans in 1955.

While Traverse City was sweeping the top brackets, Leelanau School for Boys took the class C division with 25 points. Northern Michigan Class C Conference and regional champ Boice City ended up in fifth place with 20.62 points while Harbor Springs took third at 20.67 behind Soo Leetco who finished in second with 20.67 points. Defending champion Charlevoix wound up in sixth with 15 points.

The new class D division was won by Pickford with a 59.67 total while arch rival DeTour, also of the Upper Peninsula took second at 49.67 and regional champ Wolverine finished third at 28.

The class D division was run for the first time since this year, departing from the class C-D bracket since in many schools were entered. All D times will go on record as the official records for this class.

Twenty-seven schools entered the 10th Relays here last night bringing nearly 500 entrants. In addition, over 1,000 persons watched the event, almost eight times in the state, establishing a new attendance mark. Despite the low 29 degree weather when the five hour event ended at 11:30, a good share of the crowd remained to take in all the events.

Petoskey high pitched on 22 points in the class A-B division to finish fourth behind Traverse City, Newberry with 46 and Alpena with 29.67. In class D, Petoskey St. Francis won fifth with 17 points. Six schools entered failed to pick up a single point.

The Traverse City 1/2 mile relay team that set the new record included John Schlicht, Dave Dugas, Ken Kinn and Jim Ewers. Dugas also won the 100 yard dash in 30.5 seconds.
