Protestant Unity Talks Considered By Presbyterians

 BUFFALO, N.Y. (AP) — The United Presbyterian Church decided today to open talks for unification with the Episcopal Church, the Methodist and the United Church of Christ.
 The historic action was approved with a booming voice vote at the Presbyterian's 173rd General Assembly.
 Outcome of the issue had been of keen concern throughout American Protestantism, and also among Roman Catholic leaders.
 On the event of the test, a mass ecumenical (interdenominational) meeting heard an appeal from the Rev. Dr. Robert J. McCracken, of New York City's River Union.
