

Dash Dual Highlights 4th Annual Rotary Track Meet

Three meet records were broken or tied in the fourth annual Twin City Rotary club track carnival at Filstrup Field Tuesday, but what sticks out in the memories of the fans was the dash duel between Lakeshore's Tom Reid and Richard Timm of Coloma.

Reid defeated Timm in the 100-yard dash with a 104 clocking. The Lancer sophomore grabbed the lead in the 230 only to have Timm pull up in the last 30 yards. The finish appeared as practically a dead heat with the first place going to the Coloma senior in 23.7 seconds.

Another thriller was the 880-yard run in which Benton Harbor's Bill Meeker showed a strong kick to come from behind and defeat his teammate, Harry Bilton.

The meet was run off in snappy fashion by Joe Rogers and his associates. A powdery track was perhaps the biggest barrier to the establishment of more records.
