Mt. Morris Girls Are Big Eight Rulers

Beecher's Eva Lou Voller and the standing broad jump with an Davison's Judy Goodfellow earned 8-4½ leap and Sharon Stilson of individual plaudits but Mt. Morris took the girls' version of the Big Eight Conference track title at Beecher Saturday without winning a first place.

Eva won the 70-yard low hurdles in 10.2 seconds, the 75 dash in 9.4, the high jump in 4-10 and placed fourth in the running broad jump for a personal 17 points, more than half of Beecher's total 30.

Judy won the shot put with a 29-3½ heave and the softball throw with a 168-5½ throw.

DAVISON girls won both relays. Diane Ford, Carolyn Sweers, Rilla Vannest and Kathy Sinclair took the 200 relay in 25.5 and were joined by Barbara Kellogg and Jean Treichel on the winning 440 relay in 57.5.

But Mt. Morris depth was the deciding factor, giving the Panther girls 36½ points. Kathy Zink's seconds in the 75 dash and standing broad jump were Mt. Morris's best individual efforts. Lea Stamm, Mae Herron, Vicki Fedchenko, Diana Hoyt, Connie Eves and Linda Ferris also added to the individual point total
