**Hop, Skip and Jump** — 1st. Deo (T.C.); 2nd. Roltach (Benzonia); 3rd. Park (Benzonia). Distance 37½ feet.

**High Jump** — 1st. Brando (T.C.); 2nd. Roltach (Benzonia); 3rd. Bishop (Pinebrook) and Grapes (T.C.). Height 4 feet 7 inches.

**Soft Ball Throw** — 1st. Park (Benzonia); 2nd. Bishop (Pinebrook); 3rd. Kring (Benzonia). Distance 131 feet 8 inches.

**Basketball Throw** — 1st. Park (Benzonia); 2nd. Brigman (T.C.); 3rd. Leighton (Pinebrook). Distance 65 feet 6½ inches.

**440 Yard Relay** — 1st. T.C. (Molby, Sands, Reynolds, Burrows). 1:28.9 minutes.
