

Mumford, Eastern Set Pace in Track

A year ago Northwestern won the Public School League track title by a seven-point margin over Mumford, 94-87.

Yesterday as Mumford was in the process of dominating the East Side preliminaries with 23 qualifiers to Eastern's 17, Coach Stan Mullin predicted.

"I'm sure that Northwestern will win by a wider margin this time. Redford should produce the stiffest challenge.

"I'm not conceding any race, but Henry Carr (Northwestern star) is too tough a hurdle for any opponent in the league. Redford's only chance, according to my calculations, is if Dennis Holland can finish second in both the 100 and 220. I figure we (Mumford) should wind up third."

Mumford's qualifying performances were encouraging to Mullin. The East Side defenders topped three events and shared the best effort in a fourth.
