

Birmingham Wins Its 7th Straight Title

But Ferndale Sets Only Track Mark

Ferndale High's Dorie Reid set the only record Thursday night in the annual Eastern Michigan League track and field meet on a flooded track.

Reid splashed his way to a :09.8 victory in the 100-yard dash. He also won the 220 and placed second in the broad jump in addition to running a leg on the winning 880-yard relay team.

But team honors as usual went to Birmingham. The Maples won six firsts and rolled up 73 7-10 points.

It was the seventh straight league title for coach Kermit Ambrose and his hard-working squad.

Other team totals: Ferndale 48 3-5, Mt. Clemens 25 7-10, Royal Oak Kimball 17 1-5, Hazel Park 13 ¼, East Detroit 11 ¾ and Port Huron 5.
