The muscular Pontiac Central star disappointed track and field fans earlier this season with only so-so performances. Now, however every toss is a potential record-breaker. Among his efforts this year are a new state class A record of 60 feet, 434 inches: a 61 - 1½, and a 61 - 3½ in this week's Champion of Champions at Kalamazoo. He was named the meet's out-
