

Paw Paw's Thinlies 2nd At Marshall

Plainwell Shares Third with Albion

MARSHALL—Paw Paw High finished second, two points behind champion Sturgis (46-44) here Friday night, and Plainwell tied Albion for third spot in the annual Marshall Relays.

Kalamazoo's University High shared sixth-place with Coldwater while Three Rivers was eighth.

Both Paw Paw and Plainwell picked off two first places in the relay events to help their high finishes in the talent-laden field.

Fred Emmert, Marty Hooker and Cliff Essig won the broad jump relay for Paw Paw, totaling 56 feet, six inches. And Emmert, Clarence Stimac, Dick Prawaite and Jerry McCarty formed the winning Redskin mile relay quarter, clocked in 3:37.9.

Plainwell's shuttle hurdle team won on the efforts of Cliff Kirvan, Wally Kaechele, Ray Wilson and Steve Parker. And the Trojans were first in the distance with medley with Wayne Householder, Chuck Cutler, John Hoard and Ron VanAtter timed in 11:18.7. VanAtter ran a swift 4:36 anchor mile.

U-High seized first in the sprint medley. The Cub foursome of Vince Hodge, Ron Creager, Ken Calhoun and Richie Reynolds raced to a 3:47.7 mark.
