

# Bangor Wins Springfield Relay Games

## Edges St. Philip; Richland Fourth

**BATTLE CREEK** — Bangor High outscoored Battle Creek St. Philip by two points, 56-54, here Friday night to win the annual Springfield Relays.

The Vikings, who amassed a record score for the meet, bagged only one first place but picked up points in nine of 11 events with crushing depth. Bangor was the only class B entry in an otherwise Class C conclave.

Bangor's broad jump team of Howard Jackson, Brian Lewis and Wayne MacDonald totalled 58 feet, 11 inches for a new meet record. Jackson's leap was measured at 21 feet, 9 inches.

Richland finished fourth with 34 points, four behind host Battle Creek Springfield, and the Trojans won the high jump relay with the team of Mike Rabbers, John VerPloegh and Chet McLinder. They totalled 16 feet, 9½ inches for a new record.

Also in on the record-shattering was Galesburg-Augusta whose shuttle hurdle relay team of Jim Reed, Dorman Wilson, Rene White and Roy Colville won in 1:04.5 to help the Rams to an eight-place finish in the huge field, two behind St. Augustine and Nashville who shared sixth spot.
