Chelsea Ace Sets Two Marks In Tecumseh Meet

Ann Arbor area trackmen today concentrated on preparations for this week's Regional meets after taking part in a record-shattering weekend at the Tecumseh Relays.

Fourteen records were bettered, five of them by area trackmen.

Chelsea's Dave McLaughlin set two Class B records. He ran the 120-yard high hurdles in :14.9 in the preliminaries. He was back to :15.1 later when he won the event in the rain. McLaughlin also put the shot for a new mark of 48 feet 7 inches.

McLaughlin ran the anchor leg of Chelsea's shuttle-hurdle relay unit which set a new time of 1:01.5. Running before McLaughlin were Jim Maynard, Larry Cattell, and Mike Schrader.

A Willow Run foursome—Gary Williams, Jim Troutman, Lamar Miller, and Duane Hayes—zipped around the track in a record-setting 1:36 in the Class B 880-yard relay.

Pinckney's 880-yard relay unit of John Holben, Chuck DeWolf, Ed Guy, and Jim Wicker, set a new mark of 1:37.8 in the Class C event. Complete summaries:
